

DANGER CIRCUS TO DEFY BAN

FEARLESS circus boss Pierrot Pilet-Bidot yesterday refused to tone down the world's most **DANGEROUS** acts.

Pierrot, 36, vowed his clowns would defy a council ban so they could carry on fighting and juggling with **CHAINSAWS**.

The Bizarre Archaos Alternative Circus from France — part of the Edinburgh Festival Fringe — claim to have the most violent big top in the world.

Their acts include chainsaw-wielding clowns, fire-work throwers and trapeze artists who walk the high wire **WITHOUT** safety nets.

But they were furious when Edinburgh District Council banned the chainsaw act.

Pierrot fumed: "I do not care what the council says. What do they know about the circus anyway?"

"Our show will go on. It is very dangerous but that's what people like."
